If playing chef is not the guests' forte, they have the option of ordering a meal to be delivered from a local restaurant.

A continental breakfast consisting of local jams, croissants, muffins, fruits, yoghurts and cereals, provides guests with an added treat. The morning feast is brought to the room in a hand-woven basket, ideal for eating breakfast on a summer's morning under the Cumbrian sunshine.

Ann's Hill is on the edge of the Lake District National Park and is only fifteen minutes away from the beautiful lakes of Buttermere and Crummock, whilst beautiful farmland surroundings to meander around is just outside the backdoor.

Seventeen Cumbrian farms are within the Luxury in a Farm experience. All of the venues within the group meet Visit Britain standards as they are graded at four stars or above.

There are currently seven farms offering catered accommodation and ten offering self-catering. Accommodation ranges from traditional Lakeland cottages, converted granaries, country guesthouses and an old coach house. The farms are located across Cumbria, from Hadrian's Wall area, in the North, to Barrow-in-Furness, in the South.
